EOIR to Relocate Orlando Immigration Court

FALLS CHURCH, VA – The Orlando Immigration Court will suspend regular court functions at its current location at the close of business on Wednesday, March 13, 2024, to prepare for the court's relocation. Staff will remain onsite to accept phone calls and filings until Friday, March 15, 2024.

The Orlando Immigration Court will begin accepting phone calls and filings at its new location on Monday, March 18, 2024, and will reopen for all court business at its new location on Tuesday, March 26, 2024. Parties whose cases are affected by the relocation will be notified well in advance of their next hearing.
