From August 2008 to June 2020, she served as an assistant U.S. attorney with the U.S. Attorney's Office for the Northern District of Illinois, Department of Justice (DOJ), in Chicago. From November 2002 to August 2008, she served as a trial attorney with the Antitrust Division, DOJ, in the District of Columbia. From September 2000 to August 2002, she served as a judicial law clerk for the U.S. District Court, in Houston. Judge Bell is a member of the State Bar of Texas.
