ECAS Makes Accessing Information Easier

When you need to	Without ECAS	With ECAS
Submit case filings (Notice to Appear, motions, appeals, evidence, EOIR-33, etc.)	Mail documents or travel to court and submit documents in person	Electronically file 24/7
Check on case details (status, hearing date, assigned judge, court and appeal decisions, etc.)	Travel to court or contact the Board of Immigration Appeals during business hours	View in ECAS 24/7
Obtain copies of Record of Proceedings (ROP)	Submit written request via mail or in person, or make an appointment to view ROP* at court	View/download electronic ROP* documents 24/7
Receive notification of additional case documents, hearings, orders, and decisions	Receive notifications and documents by mail	Receive notifications and access documents in near real time 24/7

*Note: Existing paper-based ROPs will not be converted to electronic files.
